



### 16-19 Opt-In Tuition Fund Information January 2021

King Solomon Academy has availed of the additional funding provided by the government to support 16-19 year olds whose education has been disrupted as a result of the coronavirus pandemic. This money is to support students who have not achieved grade 5+ in one or both of English/Maths.

The Academy has been awarded **£1,588** to support these students, specifically through tuition. The interventions below cost beyond this sum, as this document aims to capture the wider support in place for all students who fall into this category.

#### English and Maths Intervention

A primary use of this additional funding has been to provide targeted tuition for the small number of Year 12 students who have not yet achieved a grade 4 in either English or Maths. The nature of this provision has been adjusted as a result of the Autumn exam series, in which most students were successful, and is outlined below.

### **Additional Allocation**

Alongside this, we have a significant cohort of students, both in Year 12 and Year 13, who are accessing our Sixth Form courses through our Level 3 Business BTEC provision but did not achieve grades 5 in one or both of English and Maths. As such, these students need additional support to be successful. This support includes but is not limited to:

- After school intervention sessions with the Business team
- Supervised Business specific study sessions to support students with organisation and time management
- Staffing for increased numbers of mock exams to support success in the external BTEC exams
- Most A Level subjects teach 5 hours/unit; we allow 6 hours for Business to support those students who need it the most
