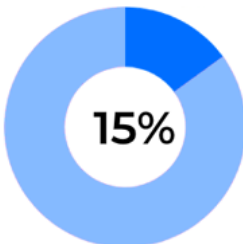
Use parental control software.



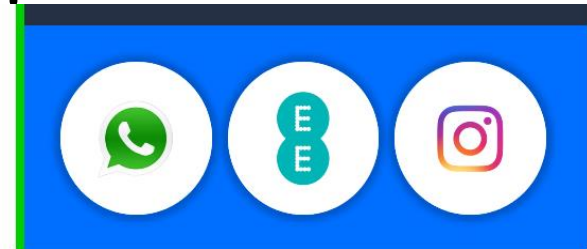
More than nine in ten parents of 5-15 control software consider it useful ¹ [

- Research showed that 62% of young people have had friend requests from people they don't know.
- Up to 48% of young people surveyed said they encountered misleading content at least once a day or more frequently, with 24% of young people encountering it 2-5 times a day.
- 25% of young people admit to sharing online content from an unverified or untrustworthy source, with 43% seeing people their own age and friends sharing something misleading.

Age-appropriate IT access

ALL: Agree boundaries (How long, when, where?)

0-5: Be in the same room; check sites/apps are age-appropriate e.g. Nick Jr, CBeebies

6-10: Stay involved (encourage children to be in the same room); check age-ratings on games/ apps

Age-appropriate IT access

ALL: Agree boundaries (How long, when, where?)

11-13: Talk to them about what they are doing and how to stay safe. Teach them about privacy on social media.

14+: Talk to them about what they're doing. Teach them about their digital footprint
