

## EMAIL SENT TO PARENTS – FRIDAY 26<sup>TH</sup> JUNE

Dear Parents/Carers of Year 7,

I hope that you and your families are all well. Thank you so much for all that you have done to support your child in their remote learning. I am writing to update you on who will be looking after the Class of 2026 next year and over the next two weeks of this term.

From September Ms Griffiths will remain as Head of Year 7 and will be Head of Year to the current Year 6 (Class of 2027). Ms Griffiths will support Year 6 pupils as they transition to secondary ahead of the summer holiday. We are so grateful to Ms Griffiths for everything that she has done to set up the Class of 2026 to be successful at KSA Secondary. Year 7 are in a very strong place to be moving into Year 8 and this is because of the way that Ms Griffiths has worked with the Year 7 team to support every child in Year 7. We are really excited for Ms Griffiths as she supports Year 6 in joining KSA secondary.
