

EMAIL SENT TO PARENTS – FRIDAY 19TH JUNE

Dear Year 11 parents and students,

Today marks the formal end of Year 11 and with it the completion of the preparation for sixth form bridging work. The bridging work has been completed by students in cohort 2 who have shown a desire to attend KSA Sixth Form in September. Teachers have been impressed by the quality of much of the work and the work has demonstrated how enthusiastic many Year 11 students are about sixth form study.

For students in **cohort 1&3**, each student has received a call from Ms Al-Hariri and the Year 11 team to ensure they have a clear plan for September. Please encourage your child to reach out to their tutor if they feel at all concerned about their plans for next year.

For **cohort 2**, the aim of the bridging work was to allow students to demonstrate their readiness for sixth form. Teachers will be reviewing this work in terms of quality and quantity against the expectations set and the sixth form team **will be contacting students in Week 5**. If bridging work meets expectations, students will receive an updated offer for KSA Sixth Form which recommends them for a place in September. Should there be concerns with the standard of bridging work, students and families will get a call from the sixth form team to discuss next steps as we will not be in a position to confirm their place in sixth form based on their current work.

Please do encourage your child to contact their form teacher in the first instance should they have any questions.
