

Primary assembly schedule 2022-23

How often do we have assembly?

We usually have two assemblies a week: one assembly, usually on a Monday, is a whole school assembly, often filmed and watched together as a class or sometimes led in person in the hall for each phase. The other assembly, usually on a Friday, is a year group or phase assembly which is in person in the hall. On the first Friday of a new half-term, we celebrate pupils who had 98%+ attendance in the previous half-term with certificates and badges.

We also have a half-termly Achievement Assembly to celebrate successes from across the half-term and award individual pupils from each class with values certificates and badges. In Key Stage Two, we also award highest attainment and most progress in each subject at the end of each long term too.

We will also run ad-hoc special assemblies to respond to specific events or needs e.g. to mark the Queen's death.

What are we trying to achieve in assembly?

- Promote and reinforce KSA Values (*e.g. focus on 'leading the way' when advertising leadership positions*)
- Celebrate pastoral and academic successes, particularly highlighting 'curriculum weeks' (*e.g. attendance certificates, reading winning entries from poetry competition*)
- Promote and celebrate equality and inclusion (*e.g. learning about neurodiversity, or Black History Month or Pride month*)
- Know significant national and international events and raise awareness of significant current events (e.g. London Marathon, or in response to events such as the Queen's death and the King's coronation)
- Recognise and mark key religious events (e.g. Ramadan, Diwali)
